Nuffield Bar, RNAS Yeovilton (opp Museum Entrance).

COURSE

Start – (neutralised) Depart HQ, follow to start/finish line.

Course – Proceed on B3151 to Ilchester where left at roundabout (M). Through Ilchester to roundabout where left (M) onto A37. Continue for approximately four miles on A37 to Coppits Hill. Left (M) at roundabout with Coombe Street Lane. Continue for approximately one mile to junction with Mudford Road where left (M) on to A359. Follow the A359 for approximately six miles to Queen Camel where take first exit at mini roundabout (M) onto unclassified road to Bridgehampton. Through Bridgehampton to junction with B3151, where left (M) onto B3151, cross start/finish line to complete one lap. (15 miles).

Finish – The finish is at RNAS Yeovilton. **Do not stop after crossing the finish line**, proceed on until it is safe to turn, please exercise caution when recrossing the finish line in case other competitors are still finishing.

Note – There will be no police to control the traffic at road junctions, marshals will be on all turns but you **must** take care at all road junctions.

Ham Hill Road Race – 5 laps. **Pittards Road Race** – 3 laps .

Gear restrictions – These will only apply to Juniors, who will be restricted to 52x14

HAM HILL ROAD RACE

Risk Assessment.

Signing on will signify that you have read and accept these conditions.

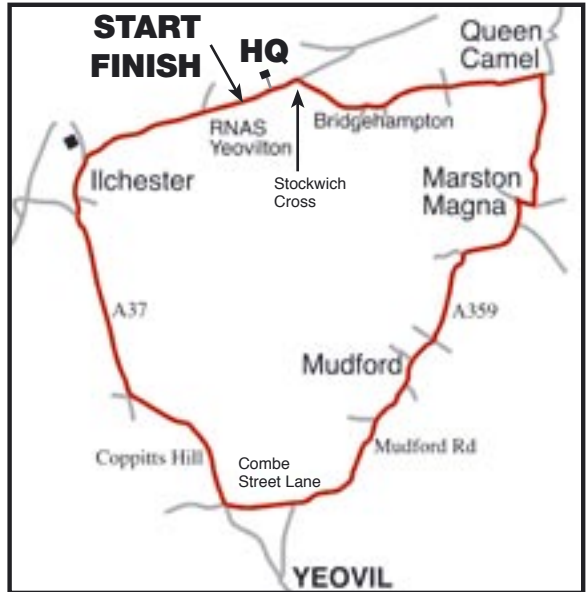
Any contravention of these regulations will be punishable by the Commissaires, and will result in disqualification from the race.

Competitors must:

- Observe the rules of the road .
- Display their competitor number clearly.
- Remove their competitor number if retiring.
- Keep to the left hand lane whilst ascending Coppitts Hill (three lane road)
- Obey any commands given to you by the Commissaires, motorcycle or static marshals. These commands may be given verbally, by hand signals or by flags, a black flag signifies the race is stopping immediately.
- Use plastic bidons, on no account are glass bottles or containers to be used.
- Sprint in straight lines at the finish.

Competitors must not:

- Pass the first lead car
- Ride in a dangerous manner



Known hazards:

Ilchester there will be parked vehicles on your left and there is a pedestrian crossing as you exit the town.

Combe Street Lane: there are central bollards erected in the road, you must keep to the left.

Mudford Road and Mudford: there will be parked vehicles on your left and there is a pedestrian crossing in Mudford Road. In Mudford there is a speed camera: be aware lead cars may have to slow. ***The road surface from Mudford to Marston Magna is poor, especially as you leave Mudford.***

Marston Magna: a sharp right hand bend followed by a short stretch of narrow road and then a sharp left-hand bend, caution; oncoming traffic may not leave you with much room.

Queen Camel: mini roundabout, be prepared for stopped traffic, or vehicles coming from your right turning onto the unclassified road, they have priority over you. Do not swing wide into approaching traffic.

Stockwich Cross: (not your right of way) Be prepared to stop. It is inevitable that you will swing wide here, marshals will attempt to control the oncoming traffic in your favour. However, this cannot be guaranteed.

All of the major junctions will have marshals, they will do their best to control the approaching traffic in your favour but you must exercise vigilance at all times

Other road users. Race officials will do their utmost to keep them out of the race but it is in your own interest to wave them out of the way as they represent a considerable danger to a fast moving bunch. We cannot allow unauthorised vehicles in the race convoy without the prior approval of the Chief Commissaire and the Organiser. Any such vehicle must be suitably signed up.

Animals. Race personnel will warn any horse riders of the approach of the cycle race. If there are cows or sheep on the course the Commissaires will almost inevitably neutralise the race until the hazard clears.

Accidents If you are unfortunate enough to have an accident then there will be first aid facilities on hand, do not assume that you have not sustained any injuries. Report to first aid and let them check you out, it is their job to decide that you are alright. If you are seriously injured then an ambulance will be called.

There is no official feeding station but the most convenient place is Coppitts Hill.
